

# ACTRA NATIONAL STUNT COORDINATOR REGISTRY

## **ACTRA maintains a list of Stunt Coordinators who:**

- have been members of ACTRA or a comparable film and television union (e.g., SAG/AFTRA, UK Equity, etc.) for at least ten years;
  - have worked at least 425 days on a stunt contract under an ACTRA or comparable union agreement; and
  - have at least 10 years of work experience as an adult performer under an ACTRA or comparable union contract.
- Note - The '425-day count' shall include days worked as a: Stunt Performer, Stunt Coordinator, Assistant Stunt Coordinator, stunt rigger, stunt safety, Fight Choreographer and/or Stunt Actor.

## **Applications Under Special Circumstances:**

- Members who do not meet the above criteria that believe they have the ability, talents and relative experience to warrant an exception for inclusion shall be considered.
- The process for the Special Application will be carried out by each ACTRA branch.
- 4 letters of reference/support from established Stunt Coordinators (*who meet the National guidelines*) will be required for all Special Applications at all branches.
- Each branch shall have an appeal process to address concerns if the initial ruling is deemed unsatisfactory by the applicant.

## **UBCP/ACTRA**

- UBCP/ACTRA Performers who meet the above criteria will automatically be added to this voluntary Registry.
  - Anyone wishing to remove their name from the Registry should contact UBCP/ACTRA at [info@ubcp.com](mailto:info@ubcp.com) (i.e., if you are not interested in being a Stunt Coordinator).
  - If at any time in the future, you wish to be re-listed on the Registry, you can request to be reinstated by simply contacting UBCP/ACTRA.
- Producers who wish to receive a list of UBCP/ACTRA Stunt Performers who have worked as Stunt Coordinators and a copy of the National Stunt Coordinator Registry may do so by contacting UBCP/ACTRA staff directly.

## **UBCP/ACTRA's Special Application Process:**

- UBCP/ACTRA Members who do not meet the National Stunt Coordinator guidelines who wish to be on the Registry may submit their request to the UBCP/ACTRA Stunt Committee at [stunt.committee@ubcp.com](mailto:stunt.committee@ubcp.com)
- 4 letters of reference/support from established Stunt Coordinators (*who meet the National Guidelines*) are required for all applications.
- Members who are not satisfied with the Stunt Committee decision may appeal directly to the UBCP/ACTRA Executive Board where a final ruling will be made.
- Members who remain unsatisfied may make a final appeal to the National Stunt Committee.
